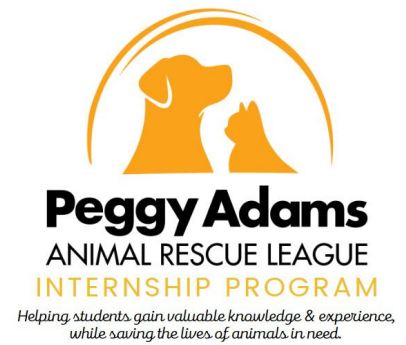


Internship Role Description
